### PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITIES

There are many occasions to perform in class, at repertoire recitals and in ensembles such as the Chamber Singers, Concert Chorale, Jazz Ensemble, Guitar Ensemble, Piano Ensemble and the 65-piece Marylhurst Symphony Orchestra. Singers may participate in Opera Workshop. Each spring there is an opportunity to solo with the symphony.

### OTHER MUSIC OPTIONS

The **Bachelor of Music in Composition** offers rigorous training for composition careers in creative media or teaching. The **Bachelor of Music Therapy** provides preparation for a career as a board-certified music therapist. The **Bachelor of Arts in Music** is a flexible program for those who perform on a variety of instruments, or who do not want to pursue a professional music focus. The **Sacred Music Certificate** is offered in conjunction with a music degree or the BA in Religious Studies. The **music minor** is available with any undergraduate degree.
