Faculty Technology Grants 2009-2010

Purpose: To promote faculty exploration into appropriate, engaging, and effective use of instructional technology in Marylhurst online and hybrid courses.

Who May Apply:

- Chairs, associate faculty, and adjunct faculty otherwise eligible to receive professional development support (per Marylhurst University policy).
- Preference will be given to fund a faculty in each of the following areas: Undergraduate, Graduate, AOP.

No. of Grants Available: 3

What a Faculty Technology Grant includes:

- \$1200 towards conference registration / airfare / hotel for Educause 2009 Conference in Denver, CO (Nov 3-6, 2009) – Teaching & Learning Track.
- Set of hand-held podcasting / vodcasting equipment (to keep).
- For adjunct faculty only: \$300 for development / deployment in your online / hybrid courses of things learned from Educause 2009 Conference track (May 2010).

Expectations of Grant Recipients:

- Participate fully in workshops, seminars, tracks at Educause 2009 Conference in Denver, CO (Nov 3-6, 2009).
- Participate in a CLT-lead debrief of conference learnings on the afternoon of Nov 6th in Denver.
- Participate in a faculty panel on what you learned at Educause 2009 at UFC and / or similar faculty gathering during Winter Term.
- Design / develop / use 2-5 new uses of technology in your online and / or hybrid course(s) during the 2009-2010 academic year, in consultation with CLT Instructional Technologist / Designer. (Note: Number required will be determined in part by scope of each project, ex. two major projects, or several minor projects).
- Share your new uses of technology periodically at faculty gatherings (ex., UFC, Faculty Orientation, Roundtables, brownbags, etc.).
- Assess the appropriateness and effectiveness of the 3-5 new uses of technology with the CLT Instructional Technologist / Designer and other Faculty Technology Grant recipients during April/May 2010.

How To Apply:

- Submit:
 - A brief description of what you are currently doing with technology to enhance learning in your online and/or hybrid courses.
 - What you want to get out of the Educause Conference (2-3 personal learning objectives).
 - At this point, how you see technology might enhance specific courses that you expect to teach at Marylhurst in the 2009-2010 academic year.
 - Include your name, Department (Primary), and e-mail / phone contact information.
 - Include a letter of recommendation from your Department Chair.
